



How to apply for funding from the British Judo Trust

Initial Enquiry

Complete to check whether your project reaches the criteria of the British Judo Trust

Full Application

Make sure you read the criteria for funding carefully. It is important to ensure that your particular project meets the trusts criteria before submitting your application.

Other information

The British Judo Trust aims to process your Initial Enquiry as quickly as possible, but maximum wait period for this key stage is three weeks from receiving the application (all applications are dated on arrival).

Initial Enquiries are first assessed by the Director of the Trust. If the Trust Director feels the project may be of interest to the Trustees, she will make contact with the individual or organisation and ask them to complete the full application.

If your initial enquiry is not successful we will let you know, communication why this application will not be taken any further.

You should only complete a full application form if your initial enquiry has been successful and you have been specifically invited to submit a full application by the director of the British Judo Trust

The British Judo Trust Trustees hold regular meetings where all completed grant applications will be considered. We will write to you as soon as possible after your application has been considered to let you know the outcome, the maximum time period for this is two months.

If you receive funding from the Trust you will be required to show how the grant has been used, with a review and full evaluation.

If your application is successful:

If your application is successful, we will contact you by telephone with full written confirmation to follow. The correspondence will contain all of the terms and conditions of this offer and instructions on how you will receive the funding and how this will be monitored throughout the project period.

If your application is unsuccessful:

We will of course contact you via telephone and give you full feedback and of course follow this with a written letter.

Data Protection:

To comply with this Act, we require your consent to use personal data supplied by you in the processing and review of your initial enquiry and your full application.
