Making a contribution is simple - all you need to do is fill out your details on the form below to agree to give a regular gift by direct debit. Remember also that if you agree to gift aid your donations,

the Trust as a registered charity can claim an extra 28p from HM Revenue & Customs for every £1 you give - meaning your support is worth even more. If you are a higher rate tax payer then you may also obtain some personal tax relief.

Official supporters of the Trust will receive a specially commissioned British Judo Trust pin badge, plus a report at the end of the year detailing the causes that have been supported.
